- For fuel retrieval from the SFP, structure dismantling and rubble removal are required. In this process, it is desirable to minimize the generation of dust.

Current state against ideal

- A wet method has been already used for retrieval. In Unit 2 and Unit 1, removal of heavy equipment has been carried out by remote control.

Issues to be resolved

- There are no issues that require investigation of new methods at this stage.
